# PREMIER KATHLEEN WYNNE PROVIDES SUPPORT MESSAGES TO CANADIAN, ALLIED MERCHANT NAVY, AND AMERICAN MERCHANT MARINE VETERANS

**Today** – Mr. Stéphane Ouellette, President and CEO, MNCTP, thanked the Honourable Kathleen Wynne, Premier of Ontario, for providing support messages to our Canadian, Allied Merchant Navy, and American Merchant Marine Veterans.

Premier Wynne also became the third Premier in Canadian history to officially acknowledge the efforts of the American Merchant Marine Veterans. The Honourable Paul Davis, former Premier of Newfoundland and Labrador, was the first. The Honourable Brian Gallant, Premier of New Brunswick, was the second.

Premier Kathleen Wynne added her Message of Recognition to that of: the Right Honourable Justin Trudeau, Prime Minister of Canada; the Right Honourable Stephen Harper, former Prime Minister of Canada; the Honourable Thomas Mulcair, Leader of the New Democratic Party; the Honourable Senator Joseph A. Day, Saint John—Kennebecasis; Her Honour, Vaughn Solomon Schofield, Lieutenant Governor of Saskatchewan; the Honourable Stephen McNeil, Premier of Nova Scotia; the Honourable Rachel Notley, Premier of Alberta; and many more.
