Bruno Charbonneau is Associate Professor of International Studies at the Royal Military College Saint-Jean. He is also Director of the Centre FrancoPaix in Conflict Resolution and Peace Missions, which is part of the Raoul-Dandurand Chair in Strategic and Diplomatic Studies at the Université du Québec à Montréal, where he is supervising, among other things, the 'Stabilizing Mali' project.

He specialises in the international politics of West African conflict management, resolution, and military intervention, notably working on the current situation in the Sahel. His research has been funded by the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada, Global Affairs Canada, Quebec's Ministry of International Relations, and the Organisation internationale de la Francophonie.
