Rebecca Jensen is completing her doctorate in strategic studies at the University of Calgary, researching how innovation influenced operational art in the 21st century wars in Iraq and Afghanistan. Previously a Fulbright Visiting Scholar and Johns Hopkins University's School of Advanced International Studies, she had also been a Visiting Scholar at The George Washington University's Elliot School for International Security and Conflict Studies, and taught at Marine Corps University.

She is currently the Shepherd Memorial Dissertation Fellow at MCU, and an adjunct researcher at the RAND Corporation. In addition to her dissertation research, Ms. Jensen has published on civil-military relations, the development of doctrine, force structure and military effectiveness, and institutional and strategic culture in western militaries. Previous education includes an MPA with a focus on public sector reform, and an MA with a focus on European history 1914-1945.
