Elinor Sloan is Professor of International Relations and Chair of the Department of Political Science at Carleton University. A graduate of the Royal Military College of Canada, she holds an MA from the Norman Paterson School of International Affairs at Carleton University, and a PhD from the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy at Tufts University in Boston.

Prior to joining academia, she was a strategic analyst in Ottawa's National Defence Headquarters, and a logistics officer in the Canadian Armed Forces regular force. The author of many books and articles, Professor Sloan writes and publishes in the field of international security studies, with a special focus on Canada, the United States, NATO and Northeast Asia.
