Mr. Hans Olav Ibrenk is Special Envoy, Climate and Security, Section for Energy, Climate and Environment, Norwegian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Mr. Ibrenk led Norway's work on climate and security during its' term in the UN Security Council (2021-22). He is a member of

the Board of the Green Climate Fund (GCF) (since 2017) and served on the Board of the Adaptation Fund 2007-2017, including serving as Chair in 2013 and 2015. Mr. Ibrenk is also the co-facilitator of the UNDESA-appointed SDG7 Technical Advisory Group. He is the focal point for climate and security, climate change action agenda, geopolitics of the energy transformation, IRENA, renewable energy and water and sanitation in the Ministry. He has more than forty years of experience from government, international organizations, research and consulting in development



cooperation, climate change, energy, water resources management, environmental financing, and capacity building, among other areas. Mr. Ibrenk previously worked at the Norwegian Agency for Development Cooperation (Norad), the World Bank and the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD). He holds a Master's degree in Environmental Engineering from University of Washington and a Master's in Civil Engineering from the Norwegian Institute of Technology.
