She was responsible for the acquisition and implementation of several research projects for governments, (international) foundations, the private sector, and others.

Dr. Van Schaik is a Member of the Committee on European Integration of the Advisory Council International Affairs (AIV) and a Member of the Supervisory Board of IUCN the Netherlands.
