Bruno Charbonneau is Professor of International Studies at the Royal Military College Saint-Jean, Senior Scientific Advisor at the Climate Change and Security Centre of Excellence (CCASCOE), founding President of the Climate Security Association of Canada, Director of the Centre FrancoPaix at the Raoul-Dandurand Chair in Strategic and Diplomatic Studies (UQAM), and Deputy Editor of the Canadian Military Journal. He is also Team Leader of the NATO Research Task Group SAS-182 on the effects of climate change on security. He has studied conflict dynamics and international intervention in West Africa for 20 years. He has authored and coedited six books, authored and coauthored over 30 scientific articles and over 20 book chapters. His most recent contributions include “The Era of Climate Security” in the Canadian Military Journal, “The Production of Climate Security Futures in the Sahel” in the journal African Affairs, and with Alexandre Giguère “The Polycrisis and the Uncertainty Possibility Space” in the journal Global Sustainability.
