Will Greaves is Associate Professor of International Relations at the University of Victoria, British Columbia, where his research focuses on climate change and security, North American security and defence, and Arctic geopolitics. He has written more than thirty refereed articles and book chapters, and co-edited two books: *Breaking Through: Understanding Sovereignty and Security in the Circumpolar Arctic* (2021) and *One Arctic: The Arctic Council and Circumpolar Governance* (2017). He is Lead for Climate and Security with three federally-funded research networks: the North American and Arctic Defence and Security Network/Réseau sur la défense et la sécurité nord-américaines et arctiques (NAADSN/RDSNAA), the Canadian Defence and Security Network/Réseau canadien de défense et de sécurité (CDSN/RCDS), and the Réseau d'analyse stratégique/Network for Strategic Analysis (RAS/NSA), and a member of the NATO Research Task Group on Climate Change and Security. Professor Greaves holds a Ph.D. in Political Science from the University of Toronto.
