Lieutenant Colonel Nicolas Hilaréguy enlisted in the Canadian Armed Forces with the 34 Service Battalion in December 1997. He received his commission as an officer in January 2001. In May of the same year, he completed his studies at the school of HEC Montréal and obtained a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration.

Promoted to the rank of Captain in March 2005, he held the position of G9 of 34 Canadian Brigade Group and established the Interagency Liaison Network. He pursued within the same headquarters as S4 / S3 plans. He is then, dedicated to the creation and the rise of the Territorial Battalion Group. In addition, he organized one of the validation exercises for the joint arms company that went to support the Vancouver 2010 Winter Olympics. In addition, he put in place logistics plans to support two Territorial Battalion Group exercises in the United States.



In November 2010, he deployed to Afghanistan, with the Operational Mentoring and Liaison Team, on Task Force 3-10 as the logistics mentor of an Afghan Kandak.

Promoted to Major in April 2012, he took command of the close support company of 34 Service Battalion. In May 2014, he held the position of Senior Logistics Officer in the Battalion. In May 2015, he was appointed Deputy commanding officer. In May 2017, he joined the 2nd Canadian Ranger Patrol Group as Deputy commanding officer and takes its command in May 2022. In parallel, he successfully completed the second year of the Joint Command and Staff Program in July 2018 and the advance logistic officer course in Dec 2018. He's married to Camille Assemat and he has three children: Lidia, Oxana and Magalie.
