Dr. Kiersten Johnson directs the United States Agency for International Development's Famine Early Warning Systems Network (FEWS NET), an Agency flagship program that forecasts acute food insecurity in the world's most vulnerable countries by integrating data on conflict, climate, agriculture, livelihoods, and markets to produce evidence-based projections that enable early warning of evolving humanitarian crises. Dr. Johnson's work is grounded in more than two decades of methodological development and research involving in-depth analyses of population, health, food security, biodiversity, and satellite remote sensing data for government and UN agencies.
