Dr. Tom Deligiannis is an Adjunct Professor in the Department of Global Studies at Wilfrid Laurier University in Waterloo, Canada. His research focuses on the peace and conflict implications of human pressure on the natural environment, particularly qualitative research linking environmental change and violent conflict.



Dr. Deligiannis is the Vice-President of the Climate Security Association of Canada, a fellow of the Balsillie School of International Affairs, and a member of the Global Military Advisory Council on Climate Change. Since 2022, Tom has been a member of NATO's Research Task Group on the Effects of Climate Change on Security (SAS-182) and a member of the Coordinating Group for Project CASA, Climate and Security Action through Civil-Military Cooperation in Climate-Related Emergencies. Dr. Deligiannis has conducted research on environmental conflict in Latin America and Europe.
