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Aniello Russo has been a Senior Scientist at CMRE since 2014. He has been leading the Climate Change and Security Analysis Project since 2023, and he was the Leader of the Anti-Submarine Warfare Environmental Acoustic Support in a Rapidly Thawing Arctic Ocean Project in 2022.

During his previous services at the Marche Polytechnic University (Italy) and at the



Italian National Research Council, he taught graduate and undergraduate classes in Physical Oceanography, Fundamentals of Meteorology and Climatology, Climate Hazards, and tutored several Ph.D. students and Post-Docs on related research topics.

He has more than 30 years of experience in oceanography and climate, and has authored or co-authored over 100 scientific publications and technical reports. He participated in over 20 oceanographic campaigns, four of which in the Ross Sea (Antarctica), and has been Scientist in Charge of CMRE sea trials in the Nordic



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Seas and Arctic region on board the NATO Research Vessel Alliance.
