Nick Almstädt is Crisis Management Initiative Leader for NATO's Defence Capacity Building package in Bosnia and Herzegovina, where he advises the Ministry of Security and the Ministry of Defence on strengthening crisis management and strategic communications capabilities. A former career officer in the German Armed Forces, he has held senior operational and staff appointments across NATO and the United Nations.



His professional focus lies on international security, crisis management and operational planning. He has led multinational teams in complex environments, serving as Chief Current Operations for MINUSMA in Mali, as a Planner with NATO's Resolute Support Mission in Afghanistan, and as Senior Military Observer with UNMISS in South Sudan, where he coordinated across military and civilian stakeholders.
