Prof. Francesco Corvaro is the Climate Envoy of the Italian Government. He serves as Full Professor of thermal science at the Università Politecnica delle Marche, where his academic work spans renewable energy systems, sustainable technologies, environmental impact assessment, and strategies for climate change mitigation and adaptation.

Appointed as Italy's Special Envoy for Climate, Prof. Corvaro represents the country in international climate negotiations and multilateral forums, with the mandate to advance Italy's commitments under the Paris Agreement and the United Nations 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. His role bridges science, policy, and diplomacy, fostering dialogue with governments, institutions, and the private sector to accelerate the global energy transition, promote decarbonization pathways, and strengthen resilience in vulnerable regions.

Beyond his diplomatic responsibilities, Prof. Corvaro has authored numerous scientific publications and coordinated projects on energy efficiency, circular economy, and low-carbon innovation. He is particularly engaged in initiatives linking climate action with sustainable economic development, emphasizing the importance of technological innovation, research, and international cooperation as key drivers for a just and inclusive transition.
