David McKinnon joined the Department of External Affairs as a trade commissioner in 1987.

In Ottawa, he held positions related to Canada's overseas trade, economic and diplomatic interests, including director for Asia-Pacific policy. From 2013 to 2017, he was Executive Director (Strategic Policy and Planning) and then Director General of the Physical Resources Bureau. Overseas, he served in Bangkok, Canberra (twice, the latter as deputy head of mission), and New Delhi, where he was responsible for the delivery of Canada's trade and investment program in



India and Nepal. He was High Commissioner to Sri Lanka and Maldives from 2017 to 2022, based in Colombo, and Chargé d'affaires at the Embassy of Canada to Central Asia in Astana, Kazakhstan in 2024. He is a Senior Fellow (non-resident) at the Asia Pacific Foundation of Canada. He comments regularly and consults on international issues, particularly related to Canada's engagement with the Indo Pacific. David holds a BA in history from the University of Toronto and an MBA from Queen's University.
