Initiative on GHG accounting of war

Lennard de Klerk (1973) is lead author of the Initiative on GHG accounting of war. He created this Initiative initially to show the impact of Russia's war on Ukraine on carbon emissions and the damage the war causes to the climate system. In later stages the Initiative expanded its working field to other armed conflicts and to military emissions in general.

Lennard developed climate projects under the Kyoto Protocol to reduce CO2 emissions in the heavy industry in Ukraine and Russia. He built the Irota EcoLodge resort in Eastern Hungary, which is the first and so far the only carbon-neutral accommodation in Central and Eastern Europe.



Lennard holds a degree in electrical engineering from Delft University of Technology and studied at Berlin technical university and the Moscow Energy Institute. In addition to his native Dutch, he speaks English, German, Hungarian, Russian, Ukrainian and Italian.
