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Olena Shevchenko is a Doctor of Political Sciences (2025) and a Professor at the Educational and Scientific Institute of International Relations of Taras Shevchenko National University of Kyiv (TSNUK). She graduated from TSNUK, having initially studied at the Faculty of Economics (Economic Cybernetics) and later at the Faculty of Journalism. She has been working at the Institute of International Relations for over 20 years. She possesses significant international experience, having served as a visiting professor at Ivane Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University and Ilia State University (Georgia), Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin (Poland), the Rakovski National Defence College (Bulgaria), and the Nicolae Bălcescu Land Forces Academy (Sibiu, Romania).



Her academic expertise encompasses international relations, international communications, global climate change communications, media communications, and corporate social responsibility. In 2003, she defended her PhD thesis titled "Public Relations as a factor of political culture in the field of international relations", and in 2025, her doctoral dissertation on "The Policy of Leading International Actors in the Context of Global Climate Change". She is the author of the monographs "Global Climate Leadership in International Relations" and "Public Relations in International Relations: European Experience and Prospects for Ukraine" (for which she was awarded the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine Prize for Young Scientists), as well as over 150 scientific publications in Ukrainian and international editions.
